2: MINUTES: The minutes of the meeting held on the 6th of May 2026 had been circulated prior to the meeting and were agreed and signed as a true account.

3: DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: County Councillor Jean Lewis - Planning

4: MATTERS ARISING:

The open culvert near Blaenffynnon had not been repaired but numerous Council workers had been seen investigating the culvert, County Councillor Jean Lewis would follow up.

Adventure Playgrounds had been out to inspect the traveller on the Zipwire and had confirmed that it was working correctly.

The clerk had found possible grants for the park and would obtain quotations for consideration and discussion.

The clerk had telephoned the solicitor whom apologised that the paperwork had yet to be submitted. The clerk would continue to request submission as soon as possible.

The footbridge by Rhydgoch had not been repaired. The clerk would follow up on this.

The clerk was progressing investigations into obtaining Litter Pick equipment and a directional sign for St. Gwynno Church.
